Principal Mr James Ludlow with George, Ahsaan, Zakia and Casey who achieved an amazing 12 A*/A/Distinction grades between them.




Congratulations to Kiran in Y13 who successfully completed a residential summer study programme in the USA visiting Yale and Harvard University.
