
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


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Well done to our House Stars of the Week

From the Chaplain....

When the God of his forefathers spoke to Moses from a burning bush in a distant land, Moses must have felt truly overwhelmed. No wonder his reaction was "What me?" Are you sure you have got the right person? God was asking him to face his fears and go back to the land he had fled in fear of his life. God was also asking him to lead his people to freedom; and Moses, not a good speaker, was doubtful of his abilities to live up to God's expectations. We too often place limits on what we are willing to try, for fear of failure. We lower our expectations to be more in line with our self-confidence than our potential and we resist any challenge which might take us outside our comfort zones. Because he trusted God and, despite his reservations, obeyed his commands, Moses would become one of the great leaders of the Hebrews and play a major part in God's plans. As God promised Moses, so he promises us: "I will be with you always". Who knows what we can achieve if we are willing to put our fears to one side and trust? Our school vision encourages us to "journey in faith without limits". I wonder what that might mean to us this week?
