You will also have the opportunity to learn new skills such as photography and Photo shop.

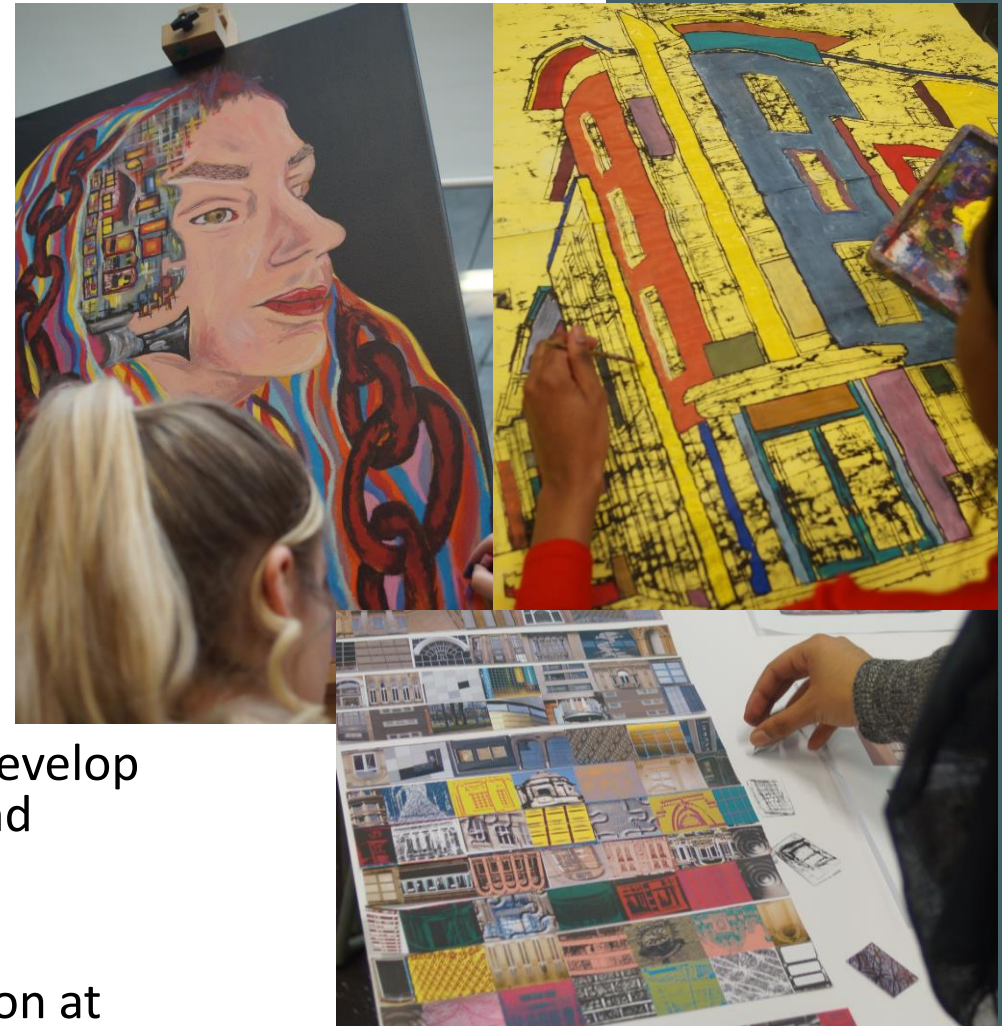
How will I learn?

Design & Technology

Students will continue to study in all areas of the D&T Department. Groups will complete projects in each of the subject areas undertaking a range of design and make activities.

Projects will build on the knowledge and skills gained in years 7&8.

The curriculum is geared towards preparing students for KS4 courses.

We offer a range of courses at KS4, including D&T, Food Preparation and Nutrition, and Engineering.

D&T subjects not only lead directly into a wide range of courses and careers, but teach you transferable skills in analysis, evaluation and creativity that can be helpful in many other subjects.
