CONTENT:

The Qualification:

- provides an introduction to the study of the Music sector
- provides the underpinning knowledge and skills needed to meet industry requirements
- develops the transferable and higher order skills so highly regarded by HE and employers.

COURSE STRUCTURE

- **Ensemble Music Performance:** learners will be expected to use the music skills and knowledge developed in their studies throughout the qualification to prepare material and perform as a musical group.
- **Practical Theory and Harmony:** Learners develop knowledge and understanding of music theory and notation and how they can be applied in practical scenarios.
- **Professional Practice in the Music Industry:** Learners explore what it is that makes someone a professional in the music industry and how to put forward a bid for work.

Learners choose one optional unit. Optional units cover content areas such as:

- composing music
- music promotion
- music performance.
- music software skills

METHOD OF ASSESSMENT

This is a new course and the finalised specification will be released in December 2017. Methods of assessment will have a practical focus.
